

Codebook for dataset for the article: Steven D. Roper and Lilian A. Barria. "Gate-keeping versus Allocating in Foreign Assistance: Donor Motivations and Contributions to War Crimes Tribunals." *Journal of Conflict Resolution* 51:2 (April 2007):285-304.

This data set includes the following variables:

1. Name of the tribunal.
2. List of states in the dataset.
3. Number assigned to each tribunal (1 = ICTY; ECCC = 2; SCSL = 3 and ICTR = 4)
4. Amount of contribution (in real dollars).
5. Whether state was a contributor at any point in time to that specific tribunal (0 = no; 1 = yes).
6. Whether the state is in the same region as the tribunal (0 = no; 1 = yes).
7. Whether the state is a former colonial power of the state in which the tribunal is located.(0 = no; 1 = yes).
8. Whether the state was a rotating member of the UN Security Council for that year (0 = no; 1 = yes).
9. Democracy score of the donor state (combination of Freedom House rankings).
10. GDP of the donor state (in real dollars).
11. Logged GDP of the donor state.
12. Logged amount of contribution of the donor state.
